The new hospital complex will accommodate the St-Joseph clinic (Liège), the Espérance clinic (Montegnée) and the St-Vincent clinic (Rocourt).

It will offer complete healthcare facilities (consultation, in-patient, check-ups, laboratory) and offer 720 conventional beds and 120 day-care places.



The new hospital will occupy an area of approx. 100,000 m<sup>2</sup> (footprint: 35,000 m<sup>2</sup>).

The two accommodation wings are approximately 200 m long and rise to a maximum 6 storeys (ground + 5).

The building rests on piles and is constructed of reinforced concrete.

It is designed to withstand earthquake loadings. The floors are of prestressed slabs in the accommodation zone and pre-slabs or mushroom slabs in the medical/technical zone.
