

Flood protection collection of Cockerill Street in Seraing and refurbishment of pumping stations No. 3, 5, 6 and 8_{temporary}

Building of the flood protection collector along Cockerill Street, the new bypass road and the Meuse dock at the bottom of Seraing, including mainly 1.9 km of pipe laying with a very low gradient (0.002 m/m).

Fiber and electrical links between pumping stations No. 3, 5, 6 and 8_{temporary} in Seraing.

Upgrading electromechanical equipment and civil engineering of pumping stations No. 3 and 5 in Seraing.

Building of the temporary pumping station No. 8 in Seraing.

Owner : AIDE (Association Intercommunale pour le Démergement et l'Épuration des Communes de la Province de Liège).

Location : On the right bank of the Meuse river, in floodplain, on the territory of the municipality of Seraing (BE).

Works : 2013 - 2015.

Studies : 2012 - 2013.

Cost of works : 6 million euros excl. VAT.

Mission : design and direction of works.
